TNPSC Group 4 Syllabus - A Brief Overview

The TNPSC Group 4 syllabus comprises three parts - general studies, aptitude and mental ability and Tamil eligibility-cum-scoring test. Candidates must complete 200 questions within 3 hours of duration, totalling around 300 marks. TNPSC Group 4 exam is conducted in two parts - Part A must be scored minimum qualifying marks of 40% to be eligible for Part B evaluation. Compared to other groups, TNPSC group 4 syllabus is less comprehensive.
